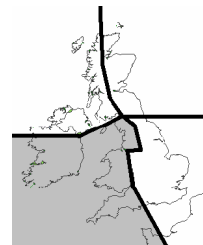

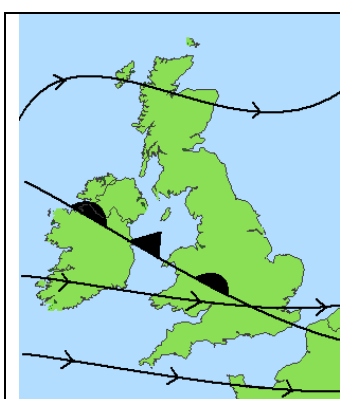

**British Aviation Summary:
based on forecast chart for Thursday**

Thursday a front will lie across southern England into Wales and Ireland. This will be slow moving to the east. A warm front will move into south west England overnight

Rain spreading north east

VFR flight possible? (VFR= cloud >3000ft & >8km vis.)	VFR in morning for Wales, NW England, then NonVFR
Lowest cloud base/top?	Wales, NW England 3000FT/5000FT, elsewhere 800FT/6000FT then throughout in afternoon
What visibility?	15KM Wales, NW England at first otherwise, 4-6KM
What weather can I expect?	Rain and drizzle but fair, dry across Wales and NW England in morning showers for S Ireland and NW England
Wind:	Surface? 250/12-15KT
	3000ft? 270/15-20KT
Freezing level?	4,000FT North, 8,000FT south
How confident are we?	High
