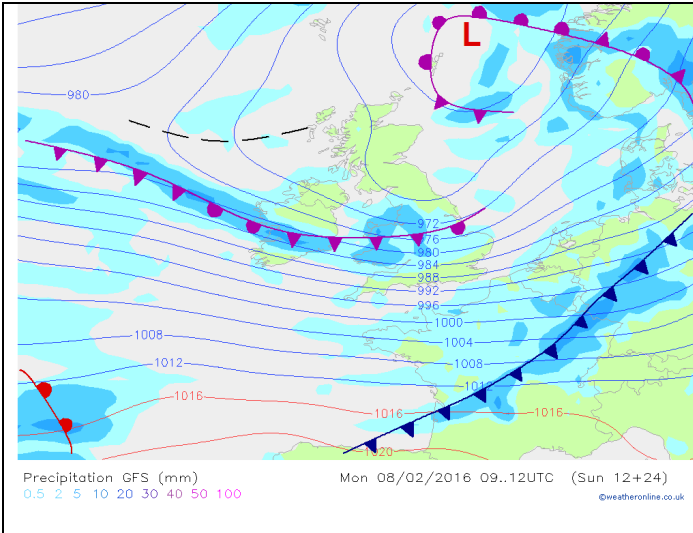

GENERAL SUMMARY for Monday 8th February 2016



British Sailing Summary:

based on forecast chart for Monday

Storm Imogen is moving NE to the north of Scotland through the day bringing severe gales to the south with storm force winds to the Solent. Winds slowly moderating through the evening and night. Splashes of rain to affect the Solent area, somewhat drier in the afternoon.

Headlines for the Solent

Stormy, WSW F7-9 gusts F10-11. Patchy rain, drier.

DETAILED SAILING FORECAST: Monday 8th February 2016

Predicted wind	SW F7-8 Southampton Water increasing to SW F7-9 gust F9 mid morning with little change through the afternoon. WSW across the Solent F8-9 gust F10-11, decreasing to W F8-9 gust F10 end of afternoon. Decreasing through the evening to W F7 gust F8, more SW across Southampton Water F7. Winds fall light overnight.		
Risk of Force 6 or above?	100%.		
Predicted sea state?	Very rough.		
Any fog?	No		
Visibility overall?	Good to moderate in light rain, spray.		
General weather conditions?	A cloudy day with patchy, light rain in the morning. A bit brighter in the afternoon, still cloudy but largely dry.		
Temperature?	+8 to +10C.	Wind Chill?	Slight
How confident are we?	High.

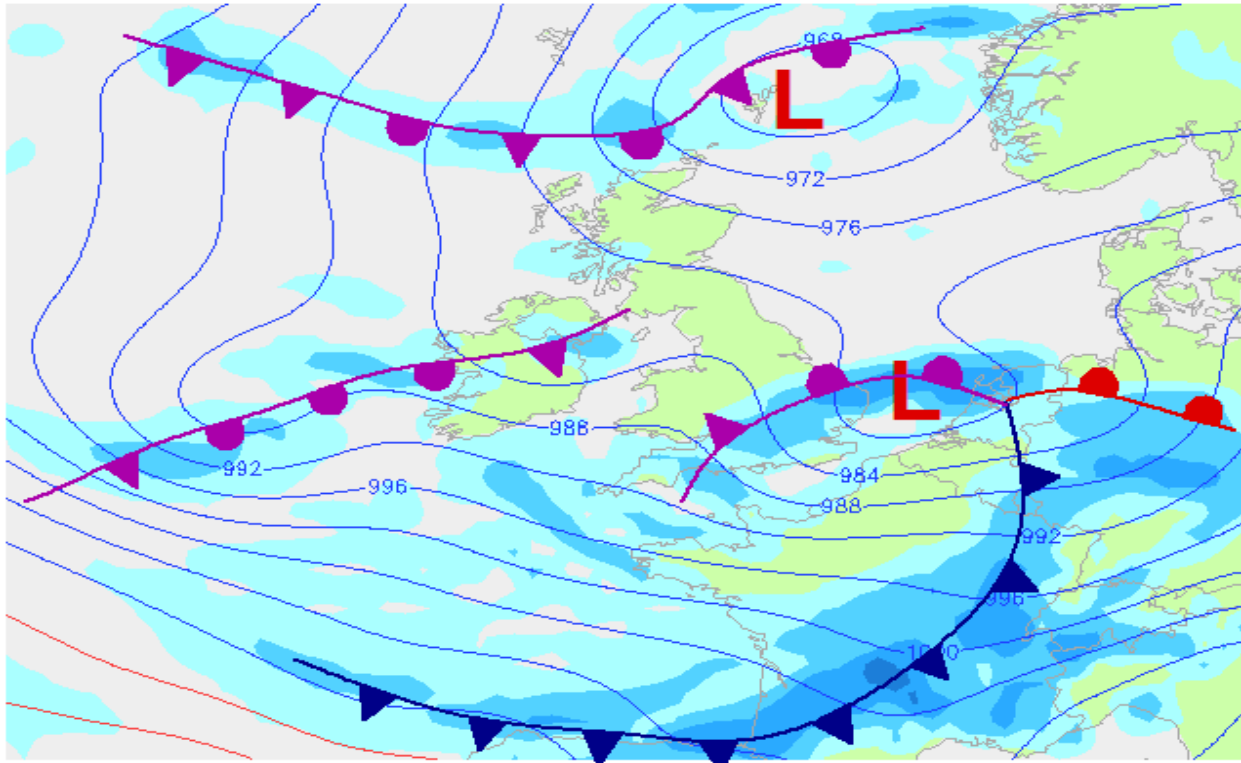

Predicted wind	SW F2 rapidly veering to the NW F4-5 but briefly F6-7 east Solent becoming W then NW in the afternoon F6.	NW F6 backing more WNW through the afternoon F5 decreasing to F4 by evening.
Risk of F6 or above?	20% rising to 70%	80% dropping to 35%
Predicted sea state	Slight then moderate.	Moderate then slight
Any fog?	No, although visibility reduced by rain, patchy mist.	No.
Visibility overall?	Moderate, occasionally poor in the morning, good in the afternoon, moderate in showers.	Good.
General weather conditions?	Overcast, misty with heavy morning rain. Brighter by afternoon with heavy showers.	A dry day with sunny spells. Some cloud develops in the afternoon.
Temperature/Wind chill	+6 to 7C, slight wind chill.	+7 to 8C, slight wind chill.
How confident are we?	High, medium to low on morning winds due to position of low.	High

PLANNING OUTLOOK: For the Solent and English Channel area

Overall it remains unsettled and rather cold with showers and longer spells of rain, but also a couple of drier days. More unsettled by the weekend with heavy rain. The winds won't be as strong but look to increase again towards the latter part of the weekend.

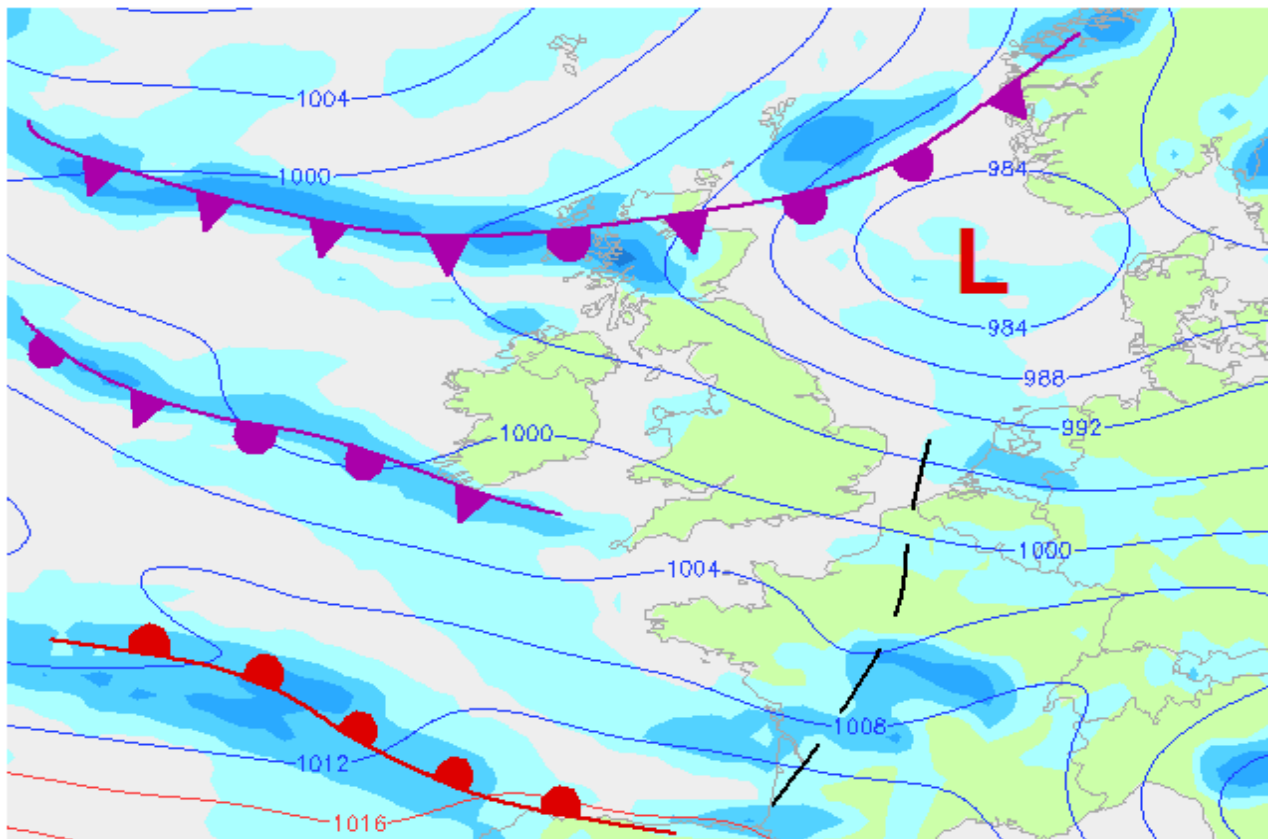


Precipitation GFS (mm)
